Let's albe honest, there's no such thing as transitioning, and the harm in that approach is it's being complicit in unleashing these forks on females. By condoning the creation of these trans adults, it's being complicit in all owing them to compete in female sports, invade women's spaces such as bathrooms, ocker rooms, home essible ters, prisons, the complete in female sports, invade women's spaces such harm in that and it's something I've stood against even before I desisted.
